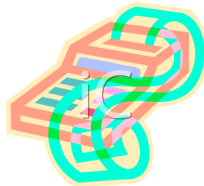


### Supporting Your Child's Numeracy

Advance notice: Our visits to Forest Schools will commence again after the holiday. All YR children will need coats and wellies on their allotted day. More information to follow soon.

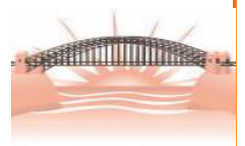
